Both plots were fenced in August, seedlings are being planted on plot 1 (195552,85), and planting seedlings on the plot 2 (81735,54), will start next year. In September we have started to plant new seedlings (about 41000 seedlings of pine) on the plot 1. As for Aftercare on the existing plot 153/1, there is constant care and monitoring of the plants and the rate of rejoicing of the existing plants is high. Also on the newly added nursery we are going to plant about 60000 seeds of deciduous tree species this year. Please see below the attached photos of the working process.
